

उपर्युक्त विषयक उप निदेशक, भारत सरकार महिला एवं बाल विकास विभाग शास्त्री भवन नई दिल्ली के पत्र दिनांक 11 जनवरी 2018 (प्रति संलग्न) का सन्दर्भ ग्रहण करने का कष्ट करें, जिसके द्वारा वर्ष 2017-18 के लिए आंगनबाड़ी कार्यकर्त्रियों को राष्ट्रीय पुरस्कार/राज्य स्तरीय पुरस्कार दिये जाने हेतु गाईड लाईन निर्धारित करते हुए निर्धारित प्रारूप पर आंगनबाड़ी कार्यकर्त्रियों के नामांकन का विवरण भारत सरकार को उपलब्ध कराये जाने के निर्देश दिये गये है।

वर्ष 17-18 हेतु राष्ट्रीय लेवल हेतु कुल 12 आंगनबाड़ी कार्यकर्त्रियों तथा राज्य स्तरीय हेतु 188 आंगनबाड़ी कार्यकर्त्रियों को पुरस्कार दिया जाना है। राष्ट्रीय पुरस्कार के रूप में प्रति आंगनबाड़ी कार्यकर्त्री को रू0 50,000.00 व प्रशस्ति पत्र तथा राज्य स्तरीय पुरस्कार के रूप में 10,000.00 व प्रशस्ति पत्र दिया जाना प्रस्तावित है।

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to send herewith a copy of the guidelines for the administration of the Awards to Anganwadi Workers under Centrally Sponsored Anganwadi Services (ICDS) for the years 2017-18.

In order to motivate the Anganwadi Workers and give recognition to their good voluntary work, the Government has decided to give annual awards to selected Anganwadi Workers on the basis of their dedication and exemplary performance. Accordingly, a scheme of awards to Anganwadi Workers has been approved for 100 Anganwadi Workers at National Level Awards and 1275 Anganwadi Workers at State Level Awards for the year 2017-18.

It is requested that State level awards for Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) for the year 2017-18 may be finalized and nominations for national level awards may please be sent to this Ministry out of the selected list of State level awardees. The nominations of AWWs for the National Level Awards may be sent to this Ministry by 15th April 2018 positively. Nominations received after the prescribed date will not be considered.

Guidelines for Administration of Awards to Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) under the Anganwadi Services (ICDS) for the year 2017-18.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 The **Anganwadi Services (ICDS)** Scheme aims at the holistic development of children (0-6 years) and pregnant & lactating mothers. It provides for integrated services comprising of supplementary nutrition, immunization, health check-ups, referral services, pre-school non-formal education and nutrition & health education.
- 1.2 Services under the scheme are being provided to about 992 lakh beneficiaries, comprising of about 807 lakh children (6 months-6 years) and about 185 lakh pregnant & lactating mothers through a network of about 13.55 lakh Anganwadi Centres.
- 1.3 The grassroots-level functionaries are Anganwadi Workers (AWWs), who are honorary women workers from the local community. The Government first formulated a scheme of Awards for Anganwadi Workers at the National and State levels for 2000-01. The Scheme is being continued on a year-to-year basis. The instant guidelines are for the years 2017-18.

2. Objective

To motivate the Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) and to give recognition to their exemplary voluntary service in child development and related areas under **Anganwadi Services (ICDS)** Scheme.

3. Scope and Coverage

The Awards will be provided at two levels, viz. at the State level and at the National level.

4. State level Awards for AWWs for the years 2017-18.

- 4.1 Awards will be finalized by State Governments/UT Administrations.
- 4.2 State-wise number of State level awards for Anganwadi Workers is given in **Annexure-I**.

- 4.3 Each Award at the **State level** will carry a cash award of **Rs.10,000/-** and a citation.
- 4.4 States will make selection of awardees on the basis of performance of Anganwadi Workers, broadly keeping in view the following: -
- i. Exemplary performance of the Anganwadi Worker in improving the coverage and quality of services to children and pregnant & lactating mothers under the Anganwadi Services (ICDS) Scheme and the outcomes achieved by her.
 - ii. Contribution of the Anganwadi Worker towards convergence with other programmes/ schemes of Central/ State Governments/ Local Bodies.
 - iii. Regular Reporting (MPR & Annual Reports).
 - iv. Enrolment of Children in SNP & PSE.
 - v. Experience of Anganwadi Worker (Minimum 5 years is recommended).
- 4.5 Recommendations will be made by District/Block level PRIs, MLAs, MPs, Women's Organizations, CDPO/District Programme Officer of Anganwadi Services (ICDS) Scheme or District Collector/Chief Development Officer.
- 4.6 The final selection of the awardees will be made out of the recommended names received from all sources by a State level Selection Committee consisting of the following:
- a. Secretary-in-Charge of Women and Child Development : Chairperson
 - b. Secretary in-charge of Health/Family Welfare : Member
 - c. Director, Women and Child Development : Member Secretary
- 4.7 **Time Schedule for finalization of State Level Awards:-**
- Recommendations from Districts/Blocks: **15th April, 2018**
to reach State Headquarters
- Finalization of nominations for State level Awards. : **30th April, 2018**

- 4.8 Expenditure on the State level Awards will be borne by the State Governments out of funds released by the Central Government for the implementation of the ICDS Scheme. Separate accounts will be maintained for the same.

5. National level Awards for AWWs for the years 2017-18.

- 5.1 Each Award at the National level will carry a cash award of Rs.50,000/- and a citation

- 5.2 The National Level Awards will be given to **100 Anganwadi Worker** to be selected by a National Level Selection Committee. On the basis of nominations received from the State/UTs Administration. The State-wise allocation of the National Level Awards is given at **Annexure-II**. For the purpose of forwarding nominations for the National level Awards, each State Government shall forward **three nominations** against each National Level Award. ~~The~~ State/UTs of Goa, A&N Island, Chandigarh, D & N Haveli, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep and Puducherry may restrict their number of nominations equal to number of State Level Awards.

The State/UT Governments will nominate Anganwadi Workers for the National Level Awards out of the awardees selected for the State/UT level Awards. Particulars of the nominees for the National level Awards will be furnished in the proforma at Annexure-III along with enclosures indicated therein.

5.3 Time Schedule for finalization of National level Awards:

Receipt of nominations for National level Awards	:	15 th May, 2018
Finalization of nominations for National level Award	:	30 th May, 2018
Distribution of National level Award	:	Date to be fixed.

- 5.4. For the National level Award, a Screening Committee presided over by Secretary, Ministry of Women and Child Development will make recommendations and a Selection Committee presided over by Minister for Women & Child Development as Chairperson and Minister for State for Women and Child development as Vice Chairperson will select the Awardees.
 - 5.5. Expenditure towards traveling, boarding & lodging of the Awardees for visiting Delhi to receive the National level Awards will be borne by the concerned State Governments out of funds released by the Central Government for the implementation of the ICDS Scheme. Separate accounts will be maintained for the same.
 - 5.6. The State Government/UTs will issue additional guidelines at their level as appropriate for effective implementation of the scheme.
 - 5.7. State Government is requested to furnish numbers of State level awards given to the Anganwadi Workers and amount spent on awarding the presentation of wards to the Anganwadi workers
